








- 1. 

Conditions of Rams

The Rams have done well this year having run on an improved pasture until June. Then they were put on a paddock of Illabo Wheat and have remained there until now. This winter has been one of the coldest I have seen for many years with a lot of snow in the mountains guarantees very icy winds for the

Monaro. Some of the rams were shorn in March with show tags and rest shorn in April.

Breeding Objectives

At GREENLAND we are continuously concentrating on improving the genetics to breed a well balanced animal that is correct in structure with good bone on a large frame and yet maintain fibre diameter with supple skins and a rich well nourished distinct crimped wool that performs well in this processing and a versatile sheep that are suitable to most environments as well as various options such as sheep that will reach the desired body weight for the meat trade or ewes that are suitable for first cross lamb mothers. Large framed sheep usually create strong competition from restocker interest. Greenland is concentrating on improving these characters which determine net returns to woolgrowers, this enables us to progress far more effectively. The strong demand for sheep and mutton make a merino operation very profitable, Greenland sheep are versatile and are highly fertile & waterproof.

WOOL OBJECTIVES

One of the most important decisions to consider when breeding Merinos is to aim for a well balanced sheep. To do this you must avoid focusing on extreme traits. The best performers for balance is the average or a little above average for all the measurable traits. The ultimate aim at Greenland has always been to breed the very best quality wool as possible. Wool quality is the key to success in eliminating fleece rot and dermatitis. The fibre must have distinct crimp definition with well aligned fibres of white waterproof wool with the correct chemistry. Good quality wool that dries quickly is the answer to dramatically reducing fly strike and thus extremely important as the industry is already experiencing chemical resistance. Good quality wool and micron are key drivers for good competition at the wool sales.

Very productive sheep come out on top for Byrne Farm Company. At Cootamundra Show Society Maiden Merino Ewe Competition. Scott Byrne, Byrne Farm Company, Wallendbeen, took home the top prize with a run of 1100 Greenland—blood ewes. Judges Brad Wilson and Glen Rubie described the Byrnes' flock as "very Productive sheep". Brad said, "You can see hes's obviously classed for wool cut, because the production on them is very good. You'd go a long way to find sheep that cut the amount theses do." When opening the wool, Glen said the fleece was soft, dense and a beautiful white wool. "For micron and wool cut, you're kicking goals." The Byrne's flock recorded a fibre diameter of 18.8micron with an average fleece weight of 6.7kg with 11 months wool growth. In 2024, they joined 2060 ewes to Merino sires with 2250 lambs weaned. Scott said, after concentrating on wool production, they were now focusing on improving the fertility of their flock.
